Coming to Adelaide in 2014

At the board meeting of the IGFR in Paris this July it was approved that The Rotary Club of Adelaide be the sponsor and host club for the 2014 Championship.

Each year the event is held some where in the world, in the past few years it has been held in Paris, Kitzbuhel-Austria, Niagara Falls-Canada, Manilla-Philippines, Antalya-Turkey and Gold Coast-Australia. Next year the event will be held at Pinehurst, North Carolina, USA and in 2012 Crans-Montana, Switzerland.



At each event we have had at least thirty different nationalities represented, Rotarians from Uganda, Nigeria, and Nepal as well as most of the European countries, Asia and the USA. Normally some 300 to 350 participants take part in the World Championship which makes for wonderful fellowship and golf for the Rotarians and partners from all corners of the world.

The event will be held from 17th-24th May 2014 with golf at the major courses in Adelaide. The participants will then have a week to travel to Sydney after the event to attend the Rotary International Conference which starts on 1st June 2014.

This will be a wonderful opportunity for Adelaide Rotarians to showcase our city and country to fellow Rotarians from all over the world. It will also be an opportunity for South Australian and Australian Rotarians to participate in an International Rotary event with out having to fly for 24 hours at great expense.

The Rotary Club of Adelaide looks forward to hosting the event and would encourage as many Australian Rotarians to participate and make our International friends feel welcome in our country.
